3. Old Business: a. Trust Funds 1. New entrance redesign money will come out of Trust funds. 2. Tree Spraying, Cicoria quote \$2600 to \$3000 Jim made a motion not to exceed \$3000. Second Ted, all in favor. B. Fees see attached list, Ted motion to approve, second Harry, all in favor. C. Flagpole update, Jeff reported the base was in and the pole is to be placed this coming Friday at the base of Town Hill.

4. New Business: a. Jeff wants to remove some signs on the North Green (old) motion by Jim second Harry, all in favor.

B. Bialek Park Update, Jeff reported to the Selectman that he needed money to proceed and was told there is no money available, so the project is in limbo. Still doing work there, flagpoles and foul poles. Selectman has authority over the land. C. Jeff mentioned about the size of the area around the Police/Fire monuments as there may be room for graves, discussion tabled until more info.

D. Hollis Tozier, Jeff needed permission for the Tozier plot, he is a paid up member of the American Legion and he has a letter on file. All ok.
