	are not significant to the scope or intent of the project. For example, shifting the	
	location of a structure <u>away</u> from the wetlands, or making a structure <u>smaller</u> . <i>If the</i>	
	proposed modifications will increase the impervious surface (e.g., larger or new	
	structures), involve new elements, significantly change grading, or involve work closer	
	to the resource area, then a Formal Amendment will likely be required instead of a	
	Minor Modification. (Submit 3 copies)	
	2) Engineered plan showing the proposed changes as compared to approved work, and	
	distance to resource area. If a sketch is submitted, you must request a waiver of the	
	requirement for engineered plans (Submit 3 copies of plan/sketch if 8 ½ x 11"; 5 copies	
	if larger).	
	3) Written waiver request for work in the mandatory subzone (No-Disturbance Zone, No-	
	Build Zone), if applicable, with required 1.5: 1 mitigation (Submit 3 copies).	
	4) Local Fee form and check for correct amount. Make check out to "Town of Ipswich".	
	Please note project address in the memo space in the check. (Submit 3 copies).	
	5) This completed form, signed at the bottom by the applicant (Submit 3 copies).	
	6) An electronic copy of all of the above (1-5) emailed to Aliciag@ipswich-ma.gov and

	7) Applicant must attend the public hearing(s).

	8) You will not receive a modified OOC; you will receive a letter approving your request.	
	This letter is not recorded at the registry of deeds, but kept for your files.	
	9) Only unexpired OOCs may be modified. The Modified OOC does not extend the	
	expiration date.	
	10) There is no appeals process for Minor Modification requests that are not approved.
