



Bulky Item Disposal Requires a \$10 Sticker

Curbside Trash Pickup Residents Only

Stickers are sold at the following stores:

Aubuchon, Conley's Drug, DJ's Variety, Richdale, Shaw's and Tedford's

Wooden/upholstered furniture that can be carried by 2 people and other household items:

- Backrest Pillow
- Bed Frame
- Bookshelf
- Bureau
- Chair
- Desk
- Dresser
- Mirror*
- Nightstand
- Recliner
- Sofa, Loveseat
- Table

Sectionals** – Up to 4 pieces, 2 stickers; 5 or more pieces, 3 stickers

Household items: Artificial Christmas tree, area rugs

Carpet rolls from ONE room (cut into 4 ft-wide sections, rolled up and tied) count as one bulky item

Outdoor items: Garden hose, patio umbrella

* Mirrors must be taped in a starburst shape across the mirror to prevent breakage

** Full sectional may be put out on the same day with the appropriate number of stickers

Please write your street address in the space provided and put your item at the curb by 6 AM on your regular trash day. **Residents are allowed to put out one item with a sticker per week.**

- NO mattresses or box springs – check IpswichRecycles.org or prepay for recycling at **Orders.ToughStuffRecycling.com**
 - NO electronics – prepay a pickup with Republic Services (781-289-0500) or bring to Staples or Best Buy (call before you go)
 - NO appliances – bring to Transfer Station for free or contact Republic Services for prepaid pickup
 - NO construction debris (doors, cabinets, toilets, etc.) – Bring to Mello or Hiltz
