

## FIRST PERIOD HOMES


First Period houses are defined as those with major structures built before 1725. Most of the homes have been modified during later periods.

The houses listed below are additional First Period homes located outside the downtown area of Ipswich. They make up the remaining early homes which number about 60 in all.
