

Mattress and Box Spring CURBSIDE Pickup

Please read and accept the following Pickup “Conforming Unit” Guidelines.

An acceptable or conforming unit:

- Free of human bodily fluids or contamination
- Free of bed bugs or other insects/vermin
- Not heavily soiled, mildewed, or damaged as a result of being in rain or snow

Any unit that does not meet the above definitions are considered by Massachusetts Law as solid waste and will not be picked up by Tough Stuff Recycling Staff. Unit will be photographed or tagged with a reason for the refusal.

If you have any question on what to do with a “non-conforming” or unacceptable mattress defined above, please reach out to **978-356-6612**.

For curbside pickup, all units must be set out in the following manner.

1. Mattress or box spring must be placed in a mattress bag to protect it from the elements and to ensure safe handling for our curbside team.
 - Reuse the bag you received when you purchased your new mattress or box spring.
 - Obtain a bag at the DPW office at time of recycling payment.
 - Provide your own bag, available for purchase at local hardware, moving or department stores.
2. **Tape the opening to secure the unit inside.**
3. **Place at the curb – NOT at the front door or on private property.** Unit(s) must be visible for pickup service.
